



DRESS CODE GUIDANCE

1. Casual

- Jeans (clean, no rips)
- T-shirts or polo shirts
- Sweaters, hoodies
- Casual dresses or skirts
- Comfortable shoes, sneakers, sandals

2. Business Casual

- Slacks, khakis, chinos
- Collared shirts, blouses, polo shirts
- Sweaters, cardigans, blazers (optional)
- Dresses or skirts (knee-length or modest)
- Closed-toe shoes, loafers, flats, dress boots

3. Smart Casual

- Dark jeans or tailored trousers
- Button-down shirts, stylish tops, sweaters
- Blazers, jackets, sport coats
- Midi-length dresses, skirts
- Dressy shoes, loafers, boots, clean sneakers (stylish)

4. Business Professional

- Suits (matching jackets and trousers or skirts)
- Tailored dresses
- Conservative shirts or blouses
- Ties (often required)
- Dress shoes (closed-toe), pumps, heels

5. Business Formal

- Dark, tailored suits or pant suits
- Formal dresses or gowns (for certain events)
- Conservative blouses or shirts
- Ties or bow ties
- Formal dress shoes, high-quality heels

6. Cocktail Attire

- Cocktail dresses (knee-length or slightly shorter)
- Dressy jumpsuits
- Dark suits with a dress shirt (tie optional)
- Dress shoes, elegant heels

7. Semi-Formal

- Knee-length cocktail dresses, elegant skirts
- Dressy separates, tailored jumpsuits
- Dark suits (tie often optional but encouraged)
- Dress shoes, elegant heels, or flats

8. Formal (Black Tie)

- Tuxedos, black bow tie, formal white shirt
- Evening gowns, formal long dresses
- Evening footwear (polished dress shoes, formal heels)
- Optional formal accessories (cufflinks, evening bags)

9. Ultra-formal (White Tie)

- Tailcoat jacket with matching trousers
- White bow tie and white wing-collared shirt
- Floor-length ball gowns or evening gowns
- Formal gloves (optional)
- Dress shoes or formal pump
